GREATER BATON ROUGE PORT COMMISSION PROMOTES NEW DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

The port is ranked 13th in the United States in total tonnage, handling over 52,917,597 million short tons of cargo annually while providing access to mid-America through the U.S. Gulf Intracoastal Waterway and the upper Mississippi River system.
